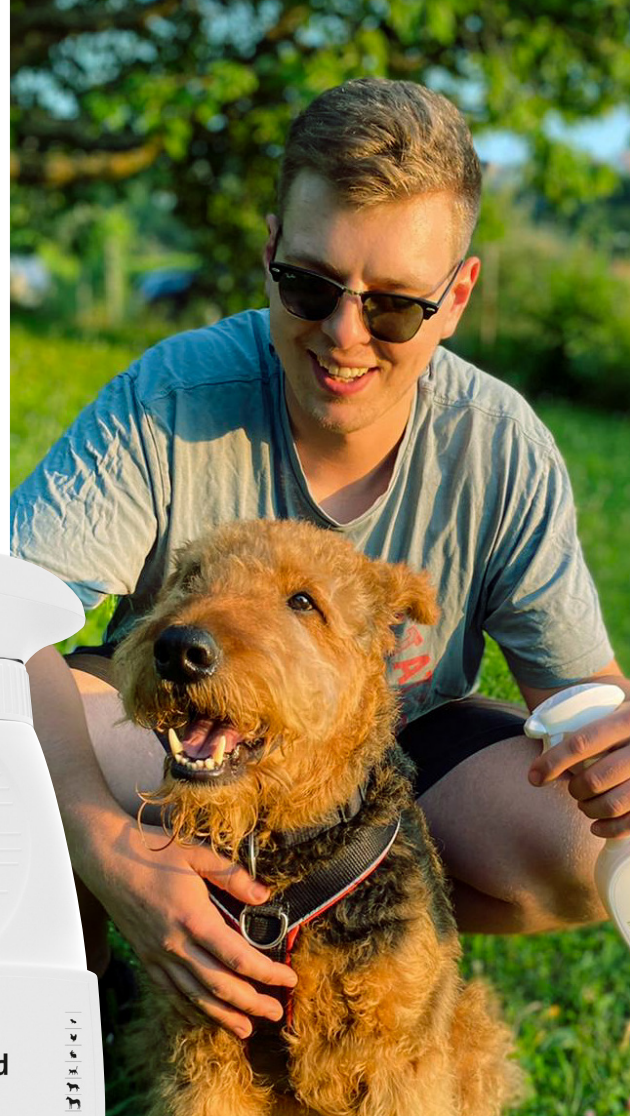

## Inuzid Spray

### Herbal protection against harvest mites, red fowl mites, ticks, mosquitoes and fleas.

Inuzid reliably keeps annoying parasites away from your pet. Instead of the synthetic version of the ingredient pyrethrin, Inuzid is made from a natural extract from feverfew. The extract does not enter the bloodstream and is therefore also suitable for puppies and kittens that are 12 weeks old. The practical spray bottle makes it easy to apply; it can be sprayed directly onto the coat or used as a surface spray for baskets, cars and stables.

#### Product type

#### Contents

130/350ml spray

#### Area of application

Skin, fur & plumage

#### Composition

Water, sesame oil, tannin, plant-based purified pyrethrum (0.09%)

#### Instructions

Shake before use. Spray Inuzid daily against the grain of the fur line or into the plumage. For cats and rodents, spray onto a cloth and rub against the fur line.

If you plan to use Inuzid against bird mites on chickens, we recommend to use it in the evening. May be applied to healthy animals from the age of 12 weeks. In the case of weak or sick animals, apply Inuzid to a cloth and massage into the coat, omitting the head.

Reapply after bathing. Also recommended for bedding and surroundings.

#### Note

Do not store over 25°C.

Use biocide products with care. Always read the label and product information prior to use.

Keep out of reach of children.

Can be harmful to water organisms. May have long-term harmful effects for aquatic life.

In case of an accident or if you feel nauseous, seek medical advice immediately.

If your pet shows any signs of unusual behavior after the application of Inuzid (such as increased saliva, dizziness), discontinue use and consult your veterinarian.

Natural product, sediments possible. Color and odor may vary slightly.

Inuzid was developed for animals and is therefore completely safe when used correctly. Inuzid (biocidal product) is also safe for humans when handled with care. We recommend that you wash your hands with soap after use and ventilate enclosed spaces during application to minimize inhalation of aerosols produced by the spray. In the event of contact with mucous membranes and/or eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and contact a doctor. Inuzid should not be used if there is an allergy or intolerance to any of the ingredients or to the natural pyrethrum. We advise pregnant women to consult their doctor before applying Inuzid to their pet.

## Ingredients (excerpt)

### Feverfew extract (*Pyrethrum*)

The purified pyrethrum in Inuzid is extracted from feverfew (*Tanacetum parthenium*). Pyrethrins are neuromuscular toxins that act as contact insecticides. They pass through the cuticle into the nervous system of invertebrates, triggering paralysis and coordination disorders within a few minutes (knock-down effect). This opens the invertebrates' sodium channels, resulting in spasms and eventually causing the death of these harmful organisms.

### Sesame oil (*Sesamum indicum oleum*)

The sesame oil in Inuzid supports the knock-down effect (parasites become unable to move within minutes) and hinders insects from breathing.

### Tannin

Tannin is a natural preservative which also has antiviral and antibacterial properties.
