

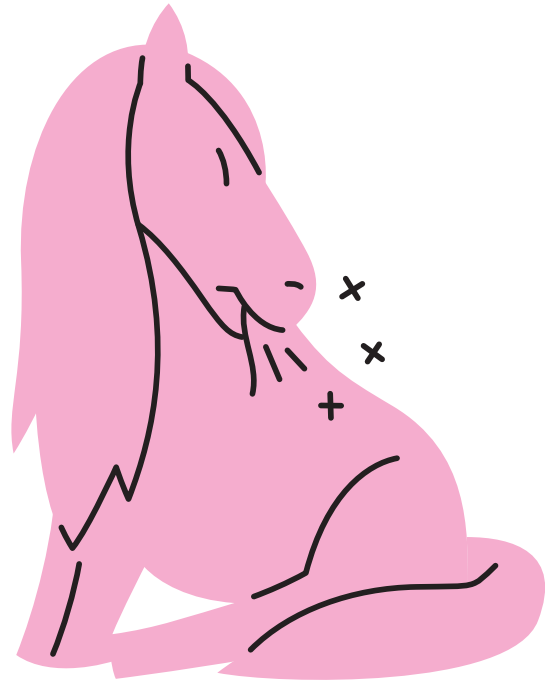

Nourishing emulsion for the support of irritated and itchy skin.

Dermin is a microemulsion with a permeation enhancer that accelerates the absorption of ingredients into the skin. It is suitable for inflammatory skin diseases, itching, redness and dry skin and it strengthens the skin barrier and the lipid layer. Dermin is absorbed quickly, contains regenerating, anti-itching and health-promoting ingredients. The added anti-licking deterrent prevents animals from licking off the emulsion.

Product type

Nourishing emulsion for animals

Net quantity

10 / 30ml

Ingredients

Brassica napus seed oil, aqua, propylene glycol, polysorbate 80, cannabidiol (CBD 2,5%), aesculus hippocastanum extract, aloe vera concentrate, ceramide 3, palmitamide mea, bitrex

Instructions

Apply the nurturing emulsion to the affected skin area and gently massage until it is completely absorbed. The pipette should not come into contact with the skin. Do not allow the animal to lick the emulsion. The emulsion does not need to be washed off, but can remain on the skin. If the pipette tip appears dirty, wipe it with a clean, dry cloth. Clean the bottle neck of any traces of emulsion residue after each use and store the bottle upright without shaking. Use a zipper storage bag when transporting the bottle.

Daily-recommended dosage

Dermin can be applied as needed to the affected area several times a day. Once the symptoms have subsided, we recommend applying Dermin for an additional seven days.

Shelf life and expiration information

Do not store over 25°C.
Use within 3 months after opening.

Suitable for external use only.

Do not apply to open or bleeding wounds.

Doping precautions

CBD, horse chestnut and aloe are prohibited substances in tournaments. It is not clear whether they are absorbed through the skin and detectable in blood or urine. Therefore, their use during competitive tournaments is not recommended. There is likewise no information in regards to the necessary grace period after skin application.

Ingredients (excerpt)

Cannabidiol (CBD)

CBD is a natural substance that can help relieve itching. It also supports the regeneration of the skin and prevents the affected areas from being scratched open.

Palmitoylethanolamide (PEA) (Palmitamide MEA)

PEA is a fatty acid amide and acts as an agonist that activates the endogenous cannabinoid receptor. It is believed to act predominantly at the CB2 receptor, thereby providing anti-inflammatory and antioxidant benefits for the skin. Although clinical studies on animals remain limited, initial studies have shown positive effects on the skin. In human studies, PEA has already shown positive effects in relieving itching, skin redness and dryness.

Horse chestnut (*Aesculus hippocastanum*)

Horse chestnut has anti-inflammatory and blood circulation stimulating properties.

Ceramides III

Ceramides are naturally found in the skin barrier. These protect the skin against dehydration and penetration of allergens. A deficiency of ceramides can lead to skin barrier damage, which in turn may cause the penetration of allergens and promote inflammation. A sufficient amount of ceramides strengthens the lipid layer and reduces water loss, improving the skin's appearance.

Aloe vera (*Aloe barbadensis*)

Aloe vera is known for its moisturizing and soothing properties. In addition, it promotes wound healing and has anti-inflammatory properties. It also has a cooling effect on the skin.

Canola oil

Canola oil is rich in linoleic acid, an important component of ceramides, which support the lipid layer and thus the skin barrier. A deficiency of linoleic acid can lead to inflammatory conditions of the skin. Canola oil also contains Omega-3 fatty acids, which help create a skin barrier and have anti-inflammatory properties. It can relieve itching and help restore damaged skin.
